

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR 2018 EMPLOYEE CONNECTED GRANTS

1. You must have Deductible Gift Recipient Item 1 (DGR1) status.

To be eligible for a grant from the Coca-Cola Australia Foundation a charity must have Deductible Gift Recipient Item 1 (DGR1) status. Please note

- Charities without DGR1 status are not eligible.
- There are a number of different categories of DGR status. To be eligible to apply for the Coca-Cola Australia Foundation you must have DGR1. If your charity has DGR2 or any other category it is not eligible.
- Charity applications under auspice are not eligible.

- 2. Your program must be based in Australia.
- 3. Your program must be targeted at young people aged 13 to 19 Coca-Cola Australia Foundation (CCAF) does not fund projects outside this age group.
- 4. Your program must inspire moments of happiness and possibilities.
- 5. Your program must address one or more of the areas below:
 - · Optimism;
 - Empowerment;
 - Increased possibilities for a positive life; and/or
 - Wellbeing (emotional, physical & social)
- 6. You must tell us whether you are applying to CCAF as the sole funder of the project.
- 7. Your program must commence within 12 months of the grant award.
- 8. You must not be seeking funds for:
 - Activities that collect funds for subsequent redistribution to other charities or individuals.
 - Purchase of land or buildings.
 - Overseas appeals.
 - Expeditions or overseas travels.
- 9. You must be aware and accept that this application is for a one-off grant.
- 10. You must have a Coca-Cola Amatil Australia or Coca-Cola South Pacific employee who is involved with/volunteering in your organisation to champion your project and apply along with you.
